IAEA - Marie Sklodowska-Curie Fellowship Programme (MSCFP) – 2022/2023

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is inviting applications from suitably **qualified Mauritian female nationals** for the Marie Sklodowska - Curie Fellowship Programme (MSCFP) 2022/2023 Cycle for scholarships in Nuclear-related fields up to two years of study, at Master's Level. Candidates can apply for scholarships for academic year 2022/2023.

Since its launch in 2020, the MSCFP has helped 210 women from 93 countries with scholarships to study towards a Master's degree in nuclear-related subjects. The MSCFP aims to help increase the number of women in the nuclear field, supporting an inclusive workforce of both men and women who contribute to, and drive, global scientific and technological innovation. Named after pioneer physicist and twice Nobel Prize laureate Marie Sklodowska-Curie, the programme aims to inspire and encourage young women to pursue a career in the nuclear field by providing scholarships for Master's programmes and the opportunity to pursue an internship facilitated by the IAEA.
