Why study in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia?

Types of Scholarships

(1) Free Scholarships

The student gets full benefits with complete exemption from any financial liability.

(2) Partial Scholarships

The student gets full benefits with exemption from some fees.

(3) Paid Scholarships

The student pays the fees and study requirements according to the University's rules>
