Other details regarding qualifications, subjects to be taught, duties, terms and conditions of employment for the post of Educator to be posted to MEDCO AGALEGA SECONDARY SCHOOL in the year 2023

1. QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates should possess:

- A.1** (i) (a) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings; **or**
- (b) Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;
- (ii) a Cambridge Higher School Certificate **or** Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”; and
- (iii) (a) (i) a degree or joint degree from a recognised institution in the subject to be taught, or an equivalent qualification; and
- (ii) a Post Graduate Certificate in Education from a recognized institution, or an alternative qualification in Education from a recognized institution; or
- (b) a B.Ed from the Mauritius Institute of Education in the subject to be taught;

(a) Qualification at (i) above should have been obtained prior to qualification at (ii) above; and

(b) Qualification at (ii) above should have been obtained prior to qualification at (iii) above.

2. French Educator to teach French and French Literature up to Grade 11.

3. Accounting Educator to teach Accounting and Business Entrepreneurship Education up to Grade 11.

4. Science Educator to teach Chemistry, Biology, and Physics up to Grade 9.

- **Biology** : Degree in one of the following -

- (a) Biology
- (b) Botany
- (c) Zoology
- (d) Biological Sciences

and

a PGCE from a recognized institution or an alternative qualification

or

B.Ed in Biology, offered by the MIE

For the post of Science Educator, candidates should possess qualifications at A.1 (i) and (ii) and in addition should possess the qualification stated above.

NOTE 1

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

NOTE 2

The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the competent authorities rests solely upon the candidates.

5. Subjects taught at School

English Language, French Language, French Literature, Mathematics, Social Modern Studies, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Design and Technology, Information and Communication Technology, Art and Design, Food and Textile Studies, Business Studies, Accounting, Business and Entrepreneurship Education and Physical Education

6. Duties, Terms and Conditions

- Apart from a monthly salary, a monthly disturbance allowance representing 60% of gross salary and a monthly allowance of Rs 2,200/- as a motivational measure will be paid to the Educators posted in Agalega.
- Salary will be paid as from the start of the academic year.
- Selected candidates will be provided with free passages (Economy Class) to Agalega and back to Mauritius at the expiry of their Contract using sea transport.
- Selected candidate will teach in both Extended and Mainstream, such subjects as he/she may be requested by the Officer in Charge of MEDCO Agalega S.S. and upon mutual agreement.
- Besides teaching duties, selected candidate will be expected to assist in the organization of various co/extra-curricular activities, such as film projections, sports, gardening, running of library, etc.
- Selected candidate will be provided with free **shared** accommodation.
- Appointment of selected candidate will become effective as from the date of their departure to Agalega from Mauritius. However, they may be recalled before completion of their Contract or their Contract terminated in the event of incompetence, misconduct or insubordination.
- Selected candidates will be expected to leave for Agalega by the first week of March 2023.
