WHEREAS the Employer desires that the Works known as Construction of a Proposed Specialist Room at Swami Sivananda SSS at Geoffroy Bambous (Girls) for the total amount of Rs. 6,129,550.00 (Rupees Six million, One hundred and Twenty-Nine thousand Five hundred and Fifty only), inclusive of a contingency sum of Rs 584,450.00 (Rupees Five Hundred and Eighty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred and Fifty only) and excluding VAT, should be executed by the Contractor, and has accepted a Bid by the Contractor for the execution and completion of these Works and the remedying of any defects therein.

The Employer and the Contractor agree as follows:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the Contract documents referred to.

In consideration of the payments to be made by the Employer to the Contractor as indicated in this Agreement, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Employer to execute the Works within a period of **180 days** as from the start date of works and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
- 4. The Employer hereby covenants to pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by the Contract.

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- 5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this agreement, J. Annauth Construction Ltd agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Ministry of Education, Tertiary Education, Science and Technology from any claim brought by or on behalf of third parties against it, its préposés and/or agents, for any loss or damage caused to third parties or on their behalf by the acts and omission of J. Annauth Construction Ltd or its employees, préposés and/or agents during the execution of the works pursuant to the agreement.
- 6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this agreement, the Ministry of Education, Tertiary Education, Science and Technology shall be entitled to claim from J.
