## **II. AGE LIMIT**

Candidates should not have reached their **70<sup>th</sup>** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications. However, priority of consideration will be given to young graduates with the required qualifications. In scarcity areas, the services of candidates up to 70 years will be enlisted.

## **III. QUALIFICATIONS**

Candidates should possess –

### **For subject No. 1-10, 12-15**

- (a) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings or
  - (b) passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (a) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (b) in six subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;

- (ii) a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”;
- (iii) a degree or joint degree in the subject to be taught from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- (iv) a Post Graduate Certificate in Education from a recognised institution or an alternative qualification in Education from a recognised institution acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**OR**

(b) passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (a) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (b) in six subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;
- (ii) a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”;
- (iii) a degree in Music (Western) or a degree in Indian Music (Vocal/Instrumental); and

- (iv)** a Post Graduate Certificate in Education or an alternative qualification in Education from a recognised institution acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**Note**

Candidates not possessing qualifications at **C (iii)** and **(iv)** above will also be considered provided they possess any of the following qualifications –

- (i) a diploma in Music from a recognised institution, obtained after a course of at least two years

**or**

- (ii) The Licentiate of the Associated Board of the Royal School of Music

**or**

- (iii) The Licentiate of the Guildhall School of Music.

Candidates not possessing qualification at **D (iii)** and **(iv)** above will also be considered provided they possess a diploma in any of the subjects mentioned at **D (iii)** above.

### **NOTE 1**

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal level” and one subject at “Subsidiary level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examination.

### **NOTE 2**

For candidates who do not possess a Bachelor’s degree in either Music or Performing Arts, their qualification should be duly accredited by relevant authorities and be pitched at level 6 minimum on the Mauritius National Qualifications Framework.

### **NOTE 3**

For Music, candidates possessing either a diploma in Music from a recognised institution or The Licentiate of the Associated Board of the Royal School of Music or The Licentiate of the Guildhall School of Music as well for Performing Arts [Bharat Natyam, Kathak, Kuchipudi and Arts/Performing Arts (Drama)], candidates possessing a diploma in the subject area will be paid a monthly allowance of Rs 21,850 plus salary compensation at the approved rates. The candidates will be paid on a pro-rata basis, based on the number of days of attendance.

### **NOTE 4**

Candidates possessing qualifications **A (i), (ii) and (iii)** or **C (i), (ii) and (iii)** or **D (i), (ii) and (iii)** above will also be considered provided they are already enrolled on a course leading to a Post Graduate Certificate in Education or any alternative qualification in Education from a recognised institution.

### **NOTE 5**

Candidates possessing qualifications laid down at **A (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv)** or **B (i), (ii) and (iii)** or **C (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv)** or **D (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv)** will draw a monthly allowance of Rs 27,400 plus salary compensation at the approved rates. The candidates will be paid on a pro-rata basis, based on the number of days of attendance.

### **NOTE 6**

The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the competent authorities rests solely upon the candidates.

## **IV. REFUND OF TRAVELLING EXPENSES**

Bus fares will be refunded on the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates.

The Application Form should be submitted along with copies of the Birth/Marriage, Academic and Professional Certificates, **transcripts of the modules covered** in the Diploma/Degree and evidence of teaching experience, if any.

## **VI. IMPORTANT**

- (i) **Candidates should clearly indicate on their Application Forms the subject for which they are applying. The subject Number should be included (eg No 1 for Accounting). Failure to do so may entail their elimination from the competition.**
- (ii) **Candidates willing to be considered for more than one subject should fill in separate Application Forms subject wise and should also indicate the subject for which they are applying.**
- (iii) **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the applicant. Only the prescribed Application Form should be used.**
- (iv) **Candidates will be contacted, as far as possible, by e-mail and phone. Candidates are therefore advised to submit valid e-mail address as well as a phone number on which they can be easily contacted.**
- (v) **The Ministry reserves the right to convene only the best qualified candidates for interview.**
