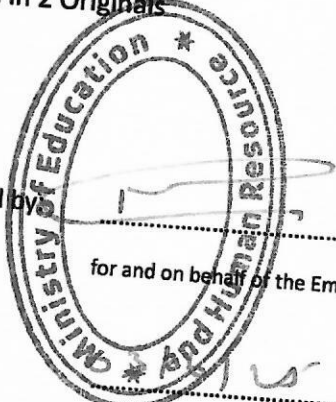
- a) the Letter of Acceptance (as per Annex);

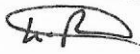
