Instructions to Fill the Proposal Form

Candidates must fill the written proposal form **in English, Font Calibri 12**, with a maximum of 3 pages, including the following mandatory points:

- 1. **Candidate Info:** Name, family name, date of birth and country of origin of the candidate.
- 2. **Title of the proposal**. The proposal title must relate clearly to the content of the proposal to be developed; and

Fellowship profile: Candidates must choose one from the following five research profiles: Management of World Heritage Sites; Immovable Heritage Research; Immovable Heritage Conservation, including with regards to Emergency Preparedness and Response; Intangible Cultural Heritage; Oases as Cultural landscapes; risk management and conservation.

- 3. Why the candidate's proposal is innovative, and makes an added value for AlUla and UNESCO? (Maximum 1/2 page): Candidates should explain the core reasons that makes her/his proposal different and innovative, and how this proposal can be interesting both for UNESCO and AlUla.
- 4. **Brief description of the proposal (maximum 1 page):** Candidates should describe and synthesize the following information:
 - a. Description of core idea (1 paragraph)
 - b. Primary Objective (1 short paragraph)
 - c. Secondary Objective(s) (1 short paragraph each, maximum 3)
 - d. Expected outcome(s) (1 short paragraph each, maximum 2)
- 5. **Brief presentation of the candidate, in a maximum of 1 page**: Candidates should introduce her/himself, describing her/his academic background, experience, and expectations.
- 6. Date and signature
