

COMMUNIQUE

OFFER OF UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ALGERIA FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Mauritian Nationals for the award of undergraduate scholarships offered by the Ministry of Higher Education of Algeria for academic year 2026-2027. Twenty (20) scholarships are available under this Scheme.

2. Fields of Study

The fields of study are indicated hereunder:

- (i) *Sciences et Technologies*
- (ii) *Sciences de la Matière*
- (iii) *Mathématiques et Informatique*
- (iv) *Sciences de la Nature et de la Vie*
- (v) *Sciences Agronomiques*
- (vi) *Sciences de la Terre et de L'Univers*
- (vii) *Lettres et Langues Etrangères*
- (viii) *Architecture*
- (ix) *Urbanisme et Métiers de la Ville*
- (x) *Sciences Médicales*
- (xi) *Sciences Vétérinaires*

2.1 The scholarship is not tenable for medicine/dentistry and medicine related fields (other than nursing and veterinary medicine).

Note:

- (a) Candidates are advised to ensure that they meet the minimum eligibility requirements as stipulated in the eligibility conditions in the documents available on the Ministry's website. A conversion table applicable for this Scholarship is as follows:

"Grade B pour la HSC correspond à une note minimale de 14/20
Grade C pour la HSC correspond à une note minimale de 12/20
Grade D pour la HSC correspond à une note minimale de 10/20"

3. Qualification Requirements

For undergraduate studies

- (i) SC/GCE 'O' Level with credit in at least 5 subjects at one and same sitting;
- (ii) HSC/GCE 'A' Level in three subjects at Principal Level obtained at one and same sitting; or
- (iii) an alternative qualification equivalent to above.

It is the responsibility of candidates to provide any relevant documentation relating to the equivalence of certificates.

4. **Age Limit**

Candidates should not have reached **25 years** of age by the closing date of application.

5. **Additional Requirements**

- (i) All interested applicants applying for Scholarships should be of Mauritian Nationality.
- (ii) Applicants should present a Medical Certificate confirming that they are clear from infectious diseases (HIV, hepatitis, tuberculosis) and are physically and psychologically healthy. Candidates are advised to initiate early procedures in view of securing this Medical Certificate such that they would be able to submit same, in case of nomination by the Ministry.

6. Applicants are reminded that, being nominated by the Ministry does not automatically guarantee final selection for an award. The final decision to award the scholarships and the choice of universities rest with the donor country.

7. **Mode of Application**

- 7.1 Applications must be made on the prescribed form available at the Scholarships Section, Ministry of Education and Human Resource, 1st Floor, MITD House, Pont Fer, Phoenix, or downloaded from the Ministry's website:

- 7.2 The completed Application Form along with all supporting documents should be submitted to the Scholarships Section of the Ministry by **Monday 07 September 2026 at 14 00 hrs at latest.**
- 7.3 Candidates should ensure that originals along with certified copies of Birth Certificates/Identity card/ Passport and educational certificates, transcripts of final university results/ marksheets four (4) recent passport size photos and all other relevant documents relating to their qualifications are submitted to the Scholarships Section by the closing date. Non-submission of these documents on time will result in their elimination from the selection exercise. Certification of documents may be done at the Scholarships Section of the Ministry or at the Careers Guidance Service, Block B, MITD House, Pont Fer, Phoenix.
- 7.4 Responsible parties of applicants not in Mauritius may apply on behalf of their wards.
- 7.5 Applicants already in employment, whether public or private, must fill in the application form in duplicate. One copy thereof along with the relevant supporting documents, should be submitted to the Scholarships Section, and one copy to the applicant's employer to enable the latter to decide on the release of the applicant for the course, and if so, on what terms and conditions. ***Such information should be made available with all other documents at the time of submission of application forms.***

8. Only the best qualified candidates will be nominated. Candidates who have not been informed of their nomination within six weeks of the closing date for application should consider that they have not been selected.
9. A Communiqué will be placed on the Website in due course to inform applicants that the selection exercise has been completed.
