

ENLISTMENT OF SUPPLY TEACHER (SECONDARY)

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND HUMAN RESOURCE

Applications are invited from **suitably qualified candidates outside the service** who wish to be considered for enlistment as Supply Teacher (Secondary) for the teaching of **Physical Education** in State Secondary Schools. Supply Teachers will be enlisted on a purely temporary basis, as and when required, during the third term of academic year **2026**.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates should not have reached their **70th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications. However, priority of consideration will be given to young graduates with the required qualifications. In scarcity areas, the services of candidates up to 70 years will be enlisted.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

A. Candidates should possess –

- (i)** (a) a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - (b) passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (a) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (b) in six subjects, including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject;
- (ii)** a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”;
- (iii)** (a) a degree or joint degree in relation to Physical Education from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Ministry;

or

- (b) a Bachelor of Education related to Physical Education from a recognised institution.

NOTE 1

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal level” and one subject at “Subsidiary level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examination.

NOTE 2

Candidates possessing qualifications laid down at **A(i) – (iii)** will draw a monthly allowance of Rs 35, 353 plus salary compensation at the approved rates. The candidates will be paid on a pro-rata basis, based on the number of days of attendance.

NOTE 3

The onus for the submission of equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the competent authorities rests solely upon the candidates.

IV. REFUND OF TRAVELLING EXPENSES

Bus fares will be refunded on the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates.

V. MODE OF APPLICATION

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The Application Form should be submitted along with copies of the Birth, Marriage (if applicable), Academic and Professional Certificates, **transcripts of the modules covered** in the Degree and evidence of teaching experience, if any.

VI. IMPORTANT

- (a) **Incomplete, inadequate or inaccurate filling of the Application Form may entail elimination of the applicant. Only the prescribed Application Form should be used.**
- (b) **Candidates will be contacted, as far as possible, by e-mail and phone. Candidates are therefore advised to submit valid e-mail address as well as a phone number on which they can be easily contacted.**
- (c) **The Ministry reserves the right to convene only the best qualified candidates for interview.**
- (d) **Candidates will have to submit a recent Certificate of Character at latest, within one month after closing date for submission of applications.**

VII. CLOSING DATE OF APPLICATION

Qualified candidates are requested to submit their applications so as to reach the Senior Chief Executive [Attn. Human Resource Section (Secondary)], Ministry of Education and Human Resource, 2nd Floor, MITD House, Phoenix **not later than 3.30 p.m on Monday 17 August 2026.** Applications obtained after the closing date **will not be accepted.** The onus for the prompt submission of applications so that they reach the Senior Chief Executive, Ministry of Education and Human Resource in time lies solely on applicants.
