Eligibility

- Either
 - A Research Master's degree with at least 2/3 of the degree comprising a thesis graded at 80%+; or
 - A Coursework Master's degree or graduate diploma which includes a research project or thesis of 10,000 to 20,000 words to 80%+ standard and research methodology units; and
 - Relevant postgraduate research experience
 - Independently refereed journal articles, publications, or conference papers
 - Professional reporting or prior learning
 - Research related awards or prizes
 - Other evidence of research ability
 - · IELTS/TOEFL scores are mandatory
