

Education (Amendment) Regulations 1987

Regulations made by the Minister under section 38 of the Education Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Education** (Amendment) Regulations 1987.
2. In these regulations-
"principal regulations" means the **Education** Regulations 1957.
3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (b) and replacing it by the following paragraph:
 - (b) For the private secondary school stage--
 - (i) a Higher School Certificate or an equivalent qualification which is acceptable to the Minister and complies with paragraph (c); or
 - (ii) where registration is sought in respect of physical **education**, art, music, dance, or craft, a Cambridge School Certificate or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Minister together with a diploma or certificate which is recognised by the Minister and based on a two-year full-time course or an equivalent part-time course;
 - (c) The qualification which shall be deemed to be the equivalent of a Higher School Certificate for the purpose of paragraph (b) (i) shall be-
 - (i) passes in two subjects at Principal or Advanced Level (with a combination of grades better than D+E) at one and same sitting, together with:

passes in three other subjects at Credit or Ordinary Level including English Language on one and same certificate;
 - (ii) passes in three subjects at Principal or Advanced Level, obtained at not more than one sitting, together with:

passes in two other subjects at Credit or Ordinary Level including English Language on one and same
4. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 June 1987.
