ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS BASED ON MERIT AND SOCIAL CRITERIA 2018

A Communiqué was issued on 27 April 2018 inviting applications for the award of 24 scholarships under the Additional Scholarship Schemes based on Merit & Social Criteria.

A selection exercise has been carried out by the Ministry of Education and Human Resources, Tertiary Education and Scientific Research in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Security, National Solidarity & Reform Institutions in accordance with the provisions of the Education (Amendment) Regulations 2013 as subsequently amended.
