Ministry of Education, Tertiary Education, Science and Technology Communiqué

The Licensing of Recruiting Agents for Overseas Educational and Training Institutions Act 2006 and as amended in 2012

This Ministry informs all responsible parties and prospective students wishing to follow courses in an overseas educational or training institutions through a local recruiting agent, that they should ensure the recruiting agents contacted are registered and duly licensed by the Ministry.

The Ministry's website, on the link hereunder, should be consulted for the list of licensed recruiting agents and the approved overseas educational and training institutions for which the recruiting agents have been authorised to recruit students.

Responsible parties and prospective students are also advised to ensure that courses provided in an overseas educational or training institution through the recruiting agent have been recognized by the relevant authorities in Mauritius.

Prospective students wishing to enroll on professional courses abroad through a recruiting agent, should ensure that approval from appropriate professional bodies in Mauritius has been obtained for professional practice prior to embarking on such courses.
