### 2. **The Fellowships are:**

- (iii) in most cases to be conducted **in English**

## 3. <u>Applicants</u>

- (i) applying for general scholar programs must be under the age of forty-five (45) and have completed at least two years of undergraduate study;
- (ii) applying for senior scholar programmes must be a master's degree holder or an associate professor (or above) and under the age of fifty (50);
- (iii) must be proficient in English; and
- (iv) must be in good health, both mentally and physically.
