## **PEACE CONTEST**

France Télévisions in collaboration with UNESCO is organising the 2nd edition of an open audiovisual creation contest **PAIX France Télévisions/UNESCO 2020/2021**. Mauritius and seven other countries have been chosen to participate in the contest.
