Education (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1966

Regulations made by the Governor, on the advice of the Minister, under section 38 of the Education Ordinance, 1957

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the **Education** (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1966, and shall be read as one with the **Education** Regulations, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations.
- 2. Regulation 27 of the principal regulations shall have effect as if in sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (1), immediately after the words and punctuation "to pursue his studies in Mauritius", there were inserted the words "a free passage from Mauritius to Rodrigues and back at the end of each school year during the currency of the scholarship ".

Made by the Governor on the twenty fifth day of November one, thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, and ordered to come into force at once.
