Applications are invited from suitably qualified Mauritian Nationals for the award of scholarships at Undergraduate level offered by the Ministry of Higher Education of Egypt for academic year 2017-2018 starting in early September 2017 as follows:

2. Fields of Study

2.1 Applications for undergraduate studies in Egypt are open in the following faculties, with students expected to indicate up to four faculties of their choice in their application form:

- 2.2 One of the choices will be granted to the applicant depending on his/her previous studies and scores during secondary level education.
- 2.3 The scholarship is not tenable for Medicine/Dentistry and Medicine related fields (other than Nursing).
- 2.4 Candidates are also advised to consult the List of Indicative Priority Fields of Study 2017/2019 available on the Notice Board, Ground Floor of the Ministry of Education and Human Resources, Tertiary Education and Scientific Research, MITD House, Phoenix, or on the following website:

3. Qualification Requirements

- (i) SC/GCE 'O' Level with credit in at least 5 subjects at one and same sitting;
- (ii) HSC/GCE 'A' Level in three subjects at Principal Level obtained at one and the same sitting; or
- (iii) An alternative qualification equivalent to above.

It is the responsibility of candidates to provide any relevant documentation relating to the equivalence of certificates.

4. **Age Limit**

Candidates should not have reached **25 years** of age by the closing date of application.

<u>Note</u>

Applicants who has applied previously on the first Communiqué should re-apply.

5. Information on the scholarships

- (i) All the interested applicants applying for Scholarships should be of Mauritian Nationality, and none of their parents should be Egyptian.
- (ii) The Student should present a Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital confirming that they are clear from infectious diseases (HIV, hepatitis, Tuberculosis) and is physically and psychologically healthy. This certificate has to be submitted by the closing date of application.
- (iii) Applicants should also submit a character certificate. Candidates are advised to initiate early measures for the obtention of the said character certificate from the relevant Mauritian Authorities. In absence of the character certificate, candidate **should** submit evidence of application for the said character certificate in the form of a copy of the receipt.
- (iv) Applicants should not have benefited from any Egyptian Scholarship before.

- (v) The Applicant should not be registered for another study scholarship inside or outside Egypt.
- 6. The final decision on award of scholarships rests with the donor country.

7. Mode of Application

7.1 Applications must be made on the prescribed form available at the Scholarships Section, Ministry of Education and Human Resources, Tertiary Education and Scientific Research, 1st Floor, MITD House, Phoenix, or downloaded from the Ministry's website:

- 7.2 The completed Application Form along with all supporting documents should be submitted to the Scholarships Section of the Ministry by **14 August 2017 at 14.00 hours at latest**.
- 7.3 Candidates should ensure that originals along with certified copies of Birth Certificates/Identity card/ Passport and other educational certificates, transcripts of final university results/ marksheets and all other relevant documents relating to their qualifications are submitted to the Scholarships Section by the closing date. Non-submission of these documents on time will result in their elimination from the selection exercise. Certification of documents may be done at the Scholarships Section of the Ministry or at the Careers Guidance Service in Rose Hill.
- 7.4 Responsible parties of applicants not in Mauritius may apply on behalf of their wards.
- 7.5 Applicants already in employment, whether public or private, must fill in the application form in duplicate. One copy thereof along with the relevant supporting documents, should be submitted to the Scholarships Section, and one copy to the applicant's employer to enable the latter to decide on the release of the applicant for the course, and if so, on what terms and conditions. Such information should be made available with all other documents at the time of submission of application forms.
- 8. Only the best qualified candidates will be nominated. Candidates who have not been informed of their nomination within six weeks of the closing date for application should consider that they have not been selected.
- 9. A Communiqué will be placed on the Website in due course to inform applicants that the selection exercise has been completed.
